Culinary & Hospitality Arts

Knife Skills, Classic Cuts, Soups, and Stocks

An introductory course that demonstrates knife skills and classic cuts used in the culinary industry. Techniques and knife skills will be demonstrated as to gain the confidence and safety skills that will enhance personal enrichment in a home or commercial kitchen. Students will participate in making soups using the techniques learned in stock preparation and classic cuts.

Therapeutic Cuisine

This course covers the principles of therapeutic cooking with an emphasis on gluten free, allergy free, and vegan cooking. Students will learn how to prepare foods for a wide variety of dietary allergens. Topics include vegan, lacto-ovo vegetarian, cornmeal preparation, and other elements of a raw food diet and food fermentation.
