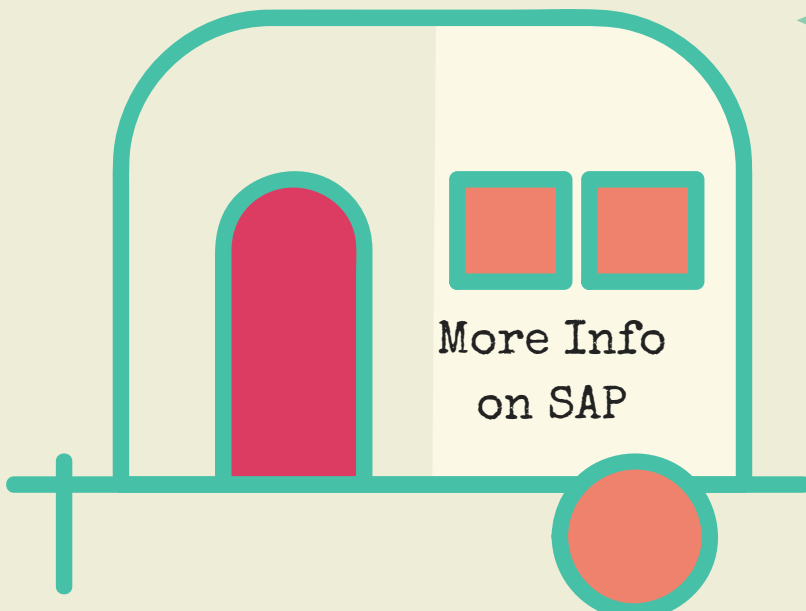

- 2.0 cumulative GPA
- 67% completion rate
- Complete program within 150% of the published timeframe

NCASFAA Conference



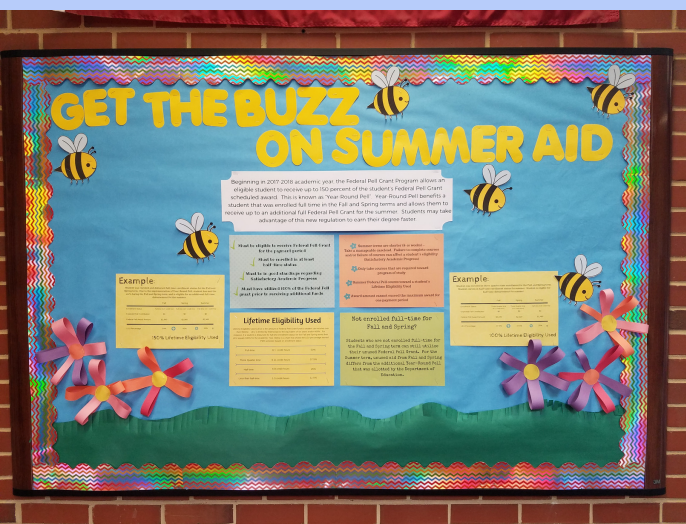

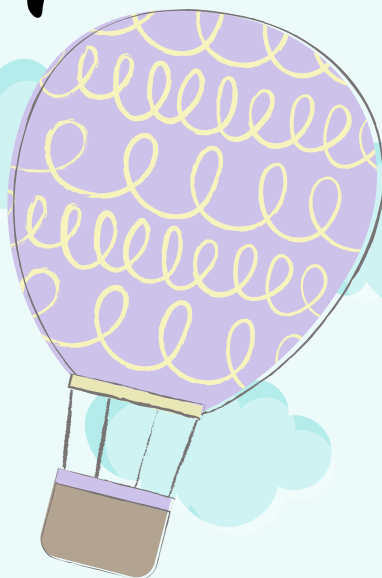
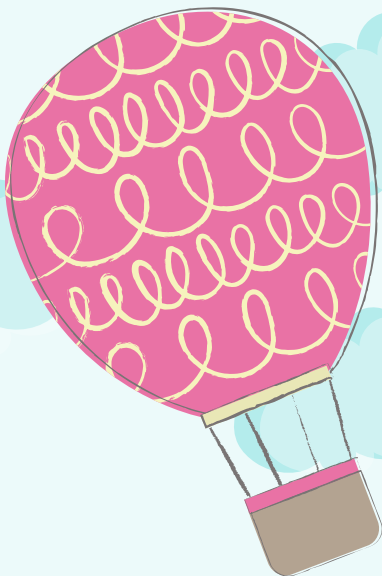
Priority Deadline

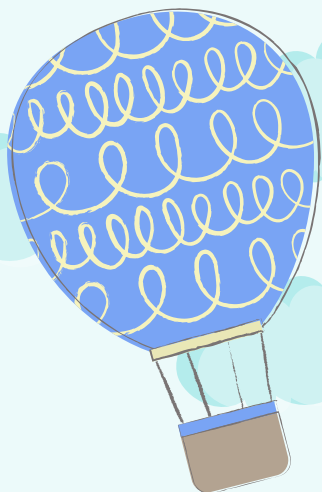

Year-Round Pell

- ✓ Must be eligible to receive the Federal Pell Grant
- ✓ Must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours
- ✓ Must have utilized 100% of Federal Pell funds for Fall and Spring

Summer Federal Pell

- ✓ Must be eligible to receive the Federal Pell Grant
- ✓ Have undisbursed aid from Fall or Spring term due to less than full-time enrollment

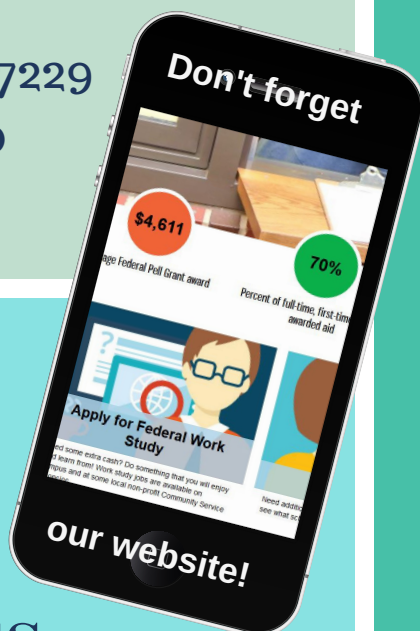
