MY SUCCESS CHECKLIST FIRST SEMESTER

WEEKS 1 – 3

- Attend classes
- Log on to Blackboard and complete orientation activities
- Meet instructors
- Find and meet advisor
- Consider career/transfer plans
- Create a habit of checking email, Blackboard, and Aviso regularly

WEEKS 4 – 6

- Meet with advisor for initial goal conversation and referrals (if needed)
- Explore transfer/academic/career options
- Get help at the Academic Assistance Center (if needed)
- Get assistance from instructors/advisor if needed – they know available services and resources

WEEKS 9 – 10

- Meet with advisor to work on academic and financial plans
- Plan to take ACA if you did not complete it in your first semester
- Get help at the Academic Assistance Center (if needed)
- Get assistance from instructors/advisor (if needed) – they know available services and resources
- Attend University Transfer Day and Info sessions for your transfer institution (if applicable)
- Apply for transfer programs (C-Step, C3, Pirate Promise, Aggie Plus, Spartan Passage, etc.) (if applicable)

WEEKS 12 – 13

- Confirm academic plan/register
- Get help at the Academic Assistance Center (if needed)
- Get assistance from instructors/advisor (if needed) – they know available services and resources
- Finish strong!
- Check grades
- Think about what went well and what needs improvement; meet with advisor if necessary to make changes for the next semester or discuss needs/resources, etc.
- Continue to explore career/transfer options





MY SUCCESS CHECKLIST FOLLOWING SEMESTERS

WEEKS 1 – 3

- Attend classes

WEEKS 4 – 6

- Meet with advisor if goals have changed or you need help
- Get help at the Academic Assistance Center (if needed)

WEEKS 9 – 10

- Meet with advisor to work on and confirm academic and financial plans
- Apply for financial aid and scholarships for next academic year
- Get help at the Academic Assistance Center (if needed)
- Get assistance from instructors/advisor (if needed) – they know available services and resources

WEEKS 12 – 13

- Confirm academic plan/register
- Get help at the Academic Assistance Center (if needed)
- Get assistance from instructors/advisor (if needed) – they know available services and resources
- Finish strong!
- Check grades
- Think about what went well and what needs improvement; meet with advisor if necessary to make changes for the next semester or discuss needs/resources, etc.
- Continue to explore career/transfer options

Repeat these steps each semester.

In your **next-to-last semester** (or based on your transfer institution's deadline), verify that you have met all graduation requirements with your advisor. Apply to the transfer institution(s)/job(s) you are considering.

In your **final semester**, be sure to apply for graduation – contact your advisor – once the semester starts.
