

TAX TRANSCRIPTS ARE BACK!

For 2018-2019, students will only be allowed to submit official Tax Return Transcripts which can be requested via www.irs.gov. Tax Returns *will not* be accepted. In addition, non-tax filers will be required to submit an IRS letter of non-tax filing status.

Priority Deadline



A valid FAFSA application and all required verification documents and forms must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office by the priority date above to receive priority consideration in the financial aid awarding process.

Applications and documents submitted after this date will continue to be processed in date order; however, you are responsible for payment of your tuition, fees, and book charges.




