Take ATI TEAS Exam	The <u>ATI Test of Essential Academic Skills</u> is a multiple-choice assessment of your basic knowledge in the areas of Reading, Math, Science, and English. Your score from the Reading section will be used when determining points toward competitive admission. Students may take this exam up to three times in a three year period. The best Reading score from the two most recent attempts will be used. There is no minimum score required for entry into this program.
