



## Student Responsibility Statement

Please read each statement and place a check once complete.

**I understand that:**

- ✓ I must notify the Veteran's Affairs Coordinator of any changes in my schedule.
- ✓ I am responsible for any debts that will result if I drop a course or withdraw from a term at any given point within the term.
- ✓ I will not be paid for excessive elective courses, previously passed courses, or other courses that do not qualify for VA benefits.
- ✓ I receive benefits only for courses that must be completed to meet graduation requirements at Central Carolina Community College.
- ✓ I must notify both the VA and the VA Coordinator of any change of address.
- ✓ In order to continue to be eligible for educational VA benefits, I must meet the VA satisfactory progress standards.
- ✓ If I am attending another university or college at the same time as Central Carolina Community College and using VA benefits, I will coordinate with each school's Veteran's Coordinator, otherwise I may not be paid.

**Please plan accordingly for the possibility of delayed payments.**

Due to large quantities of people using GI Bill benefits, the processing for VA educational benefits takes time. The VA Coordinator is not part of the Department of Veterans Affairs and cannot determine when the VA will make payments for benefits.
